Olympian High Wins San Diego County Academic Decathlon Competition for Fourth Consecutive Year

Awards Reception Honors Outstanding Students at USD's Shiley Theatre

Tuesday evening at the 31st Annual Academic Decathlon Awards Reception, Olympian High School was crowned the 2013 San Diego County Academic Decathlon Champion for the fourth year in a row. The awards ceremony was held at USD's Camino Hall in the Shiley Theatre, where all participating schools were honored.

More than 120 students from 15 local high schools took part in the February 2 competition, which was held at Olympian High School in Chula Vista.

"I'm so proud of my kids," said Ken Boulton, Olympian High Decathlon Coach and former Southwest High Coach. Boulton is the most successful coach in local Decathlon history, as he led Southwest High to five consecutive wins and now Olympian High with four consecutive wins. "Participation in Academic Decathlon is dropping off around the county and we need to get more schools involved. I would like to see all students in the County given the same opportunity to compete and participate. It is such a great experience for my students to be able to participate at the state level. I wish everyone could see the intensity and excitement of all the teams from around the state." Boulton said.
